Item I will and bequeath if my said Wife do Marry that my Children
during their Minority may be put to School and the expense thereof be paid
out of the Rent of their Estates at the discretion of their Uncle Samuel Beall the third
who is hereby appointed their Guardian if their mother do marry

Item I do hereby constitute and appoint my Beloved Wife Sarah Beall whole and
sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament this twelfth day of Sep: 1775
