Mrs. Agnes Belleau, 84 Dies In Hutchinson

Graveside funeral services were held yesterday afternoon at the Russell cemetery for Mrs. Agnes Susan Belleau, of Hutchinson, a former resident of Russell for 30 years.

The 84-year-old woman died Monday evening at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. N. Woodward in Hutchinson. She had been in ailing health since July, 1958.

Mrs. Belleau was born July 27, 1875 in South Dakota. She was the wife of Charles Belleau and they lived in Russell for 30 years. After her husband's death in 1943, Mrs. Belleau moved to Hutchinson where she has continued to reside.

In addition to her daughter, she is survived by a son, Dr. Herbert Rollow, of Chanute; a sister, Mrs. A. Finch, of Kansas City, Mo.; a brother, Ralph Greuter, of Lincoln, Nebr., and six grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren.

A funeral service was held yesterday morning from the Elliott-Gard Chapel in Hutchinson before the body was brought to Russell for final rites and interment.
